



Clinical-Field Internship Agreement

For clinical and field education (Hospital/EMS/Fire Agency)

Education internship agreement for placement of Impact EMS Training students for the purposes of developing knowledge, skills, and abilities in emergency medical care.

This agreement is made between Impact EMS Training (IET) and _____ hereafter referred to as “agency”.

Impact EMS Training is an emergency medical training program approved with the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT), approved by the Idaho Bureau of EMS and Preparedness, and an approved Proprietary School with the Idaho Board of Education. After appropriate skills training, IET students must complete a clinical-field internship to fulfill their education in pursuit of their National Registry of Emergency Medical Technician Certification.

Note: IET student liability insurance verification is also available upon request.

Agreement

Agency agrees to allow IET student to conduct clinical-field internship. Clinical-field internships consists of a recommended minimum of 24 hours observations/ride alongs (EMR/EMT) and recommended minimum of 96 hours (AEMT) with a set of skills to complete according to the student minimum competencies set forth by IET. Students, with the assistance of the IET Operations Manager, are responsible of notifying the agency and their preceptor which skills they are allowed to do to fulfill their recommended internship.

EMR/EMT observations are very general and no skills are required to be performed.

AEMT skills include, but are not limited those set forth in national AEMT student minimum competencies guidelines. Please note that all skills and assessments will have been conducted prior to the students’ field internships during the in person skills days/lab sessions.
